### The Wood Wide Web

#### TERRARIUM JAR

#### Materials ~

- ★ Glass jar
- ★ Small plants
- ★ Pebbles
- ★ Potting soil
- ★ Decorative stones or figurines

### Instructions ~

- ★ Add a layer of pebbles at the bottom of the jar for drainage (about 1-2 inches).
- ★ Pour in potting soil on top of the pebbles (around 2-3 inches), creating a space for your plants.
- ★ Make small holes in the soil and place your chosen plants inside. Gently pack the soil around the roots.
- ★ Add decorative stones or small figurines to personalize your terrarium.
- ★ Lightly water the plants, ensuring not to over-saturate.
- ★ Place your terrarium in a location with indirect sunlight and enjoy!

### The Essence of Life:
